

Paddock Hire Rules including COVID-19 update

1. If you are ill or self-isolating please do not attend. If you have had COVID-19, please follow government advice regarding how long after recovery you may stop isolating yourself.
2. We will endeavour to disinfect keypads, equipment and gates regularly throughout the day, but please either hand sanitise or use a glove/sleeve to cover your hand when using the intercom.
3. Please use hand sanitiser before and after using the arena or paddock, hand sanitiser is available by the gates of the paddock and arena. Hand washing facilities can currently be found in the toilet on the main yard. This is in the green metal shipping container nearest to the static caravan. Go round to the back nearest the hedge to find the door.
4. **If you touch it, spray it.** Disinfectant spray (virkon) is available with the equipment hire. We will be disinfecting kit regularly, but to help us, please use the spray on any items you touch. For instance if changing jump heights or moving jumps.
5. For the arena, please drive to the left of the house then turn right to park just in front of the arena.
6. For the main paddock, please park to the right of the main yard beyond the timber stack, without blocking the gate to the fields.
7. Please do not knock at the house. My apologies, but although none of us is ill, we are trying to maintain as much social distancing as possible. This is due to vulnerable members of the household.



8. In the agility paddock, those not adhering to safety advice on how to use equipment or heights of jumps will not be able to book subsequent sessions and may be asked to leave immediately. This is for the safety of you and your dog and to protect our equipment. This includes using equipment inappropriately for young dogs (under 1 year) or those with known injuries or limitations. You must inform us in advance of bringing such dogs, so that we can advise on appropriate use of equipment.
9. Paddock bookings can now be taken for groups coming from separate households, but you must ensure you follow government guidelines regarding social distancing. The maximum number of people using the paddock can be no more than 30.

These rules may be subject to change at any time, particularly with new developments and guidelines being produced by the government.
