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Things to bring to class:

- Your vaccination certificate – only to the first class
- A water bowl – preferably one that is not easily knocked over
- A piece of bedding if it is cold or if your dog prefers to settle on something soft
- A chew / food toy (e.g.) a filled Kong or rawhide chew and your dogs favourite (non-squeaky) toy.
- Training treats – these can be anything your dog enjoys from his normal kibble to liver cake / ham / chicken. Remember that classes are exciting so bring treats really nice to keep his attention in class.
- A well fitted flat collar and appropriate lead*
- The family! – Children are welcome provided they can be well behaved throughout the hour lesson; we try to get children involved as much as possible so that it is fun for them**
- Suitable clothing and footwear – particularly for outdoor classes.

Payment details

The fee for training classes is payable at the time of booking. At our discretion we will accept a deposit, with the remainder payable prior to the first class you attend.

- Life Skills 1 - £65

* A flat collar is a normal buckle or clip collar that cannot tighten with the lead. Check/choke chains are not permitted at our classes, half-checks and martingale collars are only permitted if the collar is correctly fitted so that it cannot over tighten. A well fitted collar is one that you can fit at least 2 fingers underneath, but cannot slip over the dogs head. A well fitted harness is allowed. Please speak to Jenny if your dog is usually walked on anti-pull harness or headcollar.

Leads should be long enough that your dog could walk comfortably next to you with a loose lead when the lead is held at your waist. Slip leads and extendable leads are not to be used at our classes. If you are unsure whether you have the right collar and lead, please ask.

** If your children are likely to distract you from training you are welcome to bring an extra adult!
